## **Against Good Government**

## **Against Self-defense**

Voted to allow some public entities to violate state law regarding firearms (HB1314)  
Voted to retain vague language about who may lawfully carry a firearm (HB1400)  
Voted against the right of law-abiding citizens to carry a weapon in a vehicle (HB1645)  
Voted to retain vague language about who may lawfully carry a firearm (SB336)

## **For Killing Good jobs**

Voted to encourage the use of robots in place of tipped employees (HB1346)

## **More bad votes**

Voted to eliminate a requirement that healthy people must work to receive free health insurance (HB1696)  
Voted to subsidize people who work out of state (HB2016)
