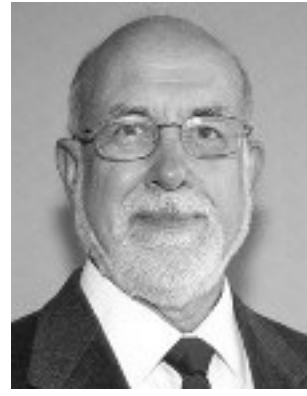


RINO of the Day: David Pierce

Against Civil Rights

Voted against informing juries of their right to find "the law is an ass" and refuse to convict (HB1270)
Voted to keep an unconstitutional law that restricts free speech (HB1570)

Against Good Education

Voted against a requirement that public schools teach the meaning of the National Anthem and the Pledge of Allegiance during patriotic weeks of Veterans Day and Memorial Day (HB1300)

Against Good Government

Voted to allow bureaucrats to set fees without legislative approval (HB1524)
Voted against making the Attorney General more accountable to the citizens than to the Governor (CACR21)
Voted to allow many state employees to be classified as "supervisor" even if they don't supervise anyone (HB1122)
Voted to provide free health insurance to childless, able-bodied adults (HB1696)
Voted against requiring police to return recovered stolen property back to its rightful owner in a timely fashion (HB1125)
Voted against a NH balanced budget amendment (CACR27)
Voted against truth and transparency in the NH House's official records ()

Against Good Health

Voted to prohibit people from buying health insurance from out of state (HB128)
Voted to ban noise-quieting devices on rifles and shotguns (HB500)
Voted to discourage creation of state-of-the-art medical facilities (SB481)

Against Parents

Voted to reduce parents' ability to control their children's health, education, and welfare (CACR16)
Voted against declaring that parents have the natural right to control their children's health, education, and welfare (HB1471)
Voted for a guilty-until-proven-innocent definition of child neglect (SB515)

Against Self-defense

Voted against allowing members of the national guard to defend themselves while on base (HB1288)
Voted to allow some public entities to violate state law regarding firearms (HB1314)
Voted to retain vague language about who may lawfully carry a firearm (HB1400)
Voted against the right of law-abiding citizens to carry a weapon in a vehicle (HB1645)

For Higher Taxes

Voted to create a new tax on capital gains (HB634)

More bad votes

Voted to allow the commissioner of insurance to secretly take over any private insurance company (SB110)
Voted to subsidize people who work out of state (HB2016)
Voted for higher cost electricity (HB1374)
Voted to replace the fire code with one that has not yet stood the test of time (HB427)
