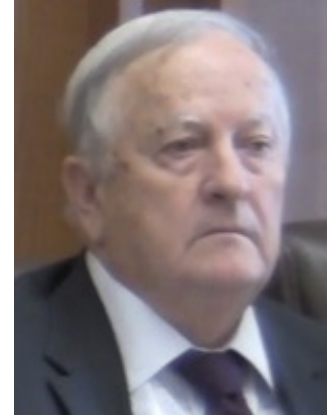


RINO of the Day: Daniel Donovan

Against Civil Rights

Voted to keep an unconstitutional law that restricts free speech (HB1570)

Against Good Government

Voted to allow bureaucrats to set fees without legislative approval (HB1524)

Voted against making the Attorney General more accountable to the citizens than to the Governor (CACR21)

Voted against parents determining when employment is appropriate for their children (HB1301)

Against Self-defense

Voted to allow some public entities to violate state law regarding firearms (HB1314)
